Definitions:

Bylaws: General directives from the member Area's regarding what services to provide to them. Bylaws are required to be approved by the member groups.

Major Motions: Specific directives given to the RSC by the member areas on how to provide those services. Major Motions are not required to be approved by the member groups.

Guidelines: Specific detailed guidance given to the RSC Officers and the Sub-Committees by the member areas on how to provide those services. Guidelines must be approved by the member areas as represented by their RCM's, but not necessarily by the member groups.
