

## **Pacific Cascade Region Major Motions**

Major Motions will include the Motion number and the date of the Motion.

- 1) The RSC meetings shall not be held on the last weekend of any month. (Motion #6, July 1993)
- 2) That we close the RSC meetings with the “Third Step Prayer” from now on. (Motion #11, July 1990)
- 3) Read the 12 Concepts of Service at the RSC after the reading of the 12 Traditions. (Motion# 7, July 1992)
- 4) All Regional events shall be handicap accessible. (Motion #3, July 1996)
- 5) To make all indoor Regional functions non-smoking, with a designated smoking area provided. (Motion#6, July 1996)
- 6) That the Regional Business meeting takes priority over planned non-business activities during a conference. (Motion#5, October 1998)
- 7) That the PCRSC reinstate “Back to Basics Regional Learning Days” with the first bid being approved in July 1997. (Motion#7, October 1996)
- 8) Give a vote of confidence to provide basic Liability Insurance for at least 2 events- The PCRCNA-XII event and the July RSC and the accrued \$2,000.00 to the regional treasurer. (Motion#3, April 2006)
- 9) To suspend Major Motion #1 “The RSC meetings shall not be held on Conference the last weekend of any month.” For the October 2006 Regional Service. (Motion#4, April 2006)
- 10) To set aside up to \$2,100.00 for the potential short-fall for PNW #29 to be available for the January 2007 RSC to be dispersed as needed. (Motion#3, October 2006)
- 11) Any motion with a financial impact to the Region of \$1,500.00 or more be returned to areas for approval (vote). A 2/3 majority vote can suspend this motion per emergency need/occurrence. Intent of Motion: to allow the fellowship to be more involved in directing and responsibly funding this Region’s needs and wants. (Motion #6, April 2007)
- 12) To purchase “Quick Books for Non-Profits” to improve financial reporting. (Motion #1, January 2007)
- 13) Revise PCR Website Guidelines, Section8: technical Guidelines, Item#1&2; The Software used for the website publishing is Microsoft Frontpage-“Website host must support Microsoft Frontpage server extensions.” To completely remove this line item from Guidelines. Intent of motion: frontpage is no longer supported by Microsoft. 6<sup>th</sup> Tradition- naming a single product implies endorsement in NA Guidelines. (Motion#7, October 2007)
- 14) To move the April 18<sup>th</sup> 2009 RSC meeting from Saturday to Sunday April 19<sup>th</sup> 2009(this would be a one-time motion) if the LBL Area is awarded the bid. Intent of motion: LBL Area intends to bid for PI/H&I Learning Day for 2009, but

- changing this RSC would facilitate a two day Learning Days and have more accessibility for all. (Motion#8, February 2008)
- 15) Amendment to the Pacific Cascade Regional Service Committee By-Laws. Intent of motion: To create the position of Chairperson of the Pacific Northwest Convention of NA. (Motion #8,10/20/07, passed 4/19/09)
  - 16) Amend insert into PCR-PI Guidelines for approval. Intent of motion: Update Guidelines and include PI job descriptions. (Motion #7,February 2008)
  - 17) Revise Website Guidelines- Section 10, Line 1: Clean time requirements-Reads: The minimum clean time for Web servant is 4 years and Web servant alternate is 2 years. Change to 2 years for Web servant and 1 year for alternate. Intent of motion: Requirements may be too restrictive to find suitable replacements. (Motion#5, April 2008)
  - 18) To reserve \$2,150.00 to fully replenish seed money for events: \$1,200.00-PCRCNA, \$350.00-PCRSC, \$600.00-PCRSCA. (Motion#4, April 2008)
  - 19) To increase the seed money for our Regional Convention (PCRCNA XVI) as a one-time dispensation of \$1,200.00. (Motion#1, July 2008)
  - 20) Amend Officer and Sub-Committee Chair travel allotment in the budget to \$45.00. (Motion#3, July 2008)
  - 21) To forward \$1,000.00 accrued RD World Service Meeting travel held to NAWS. (Motion#4, July 2008)
  - 22) To endorse PNWCNA #33 bid, to be hosted by the Pacific Cascade Region, held September 30-October 2,2010 in Portland, Or.. (Motion #1, October 2008)
