- C) Assembly Open Forum
 - 1) Large meeting of all participants of the Regional Assembly.
 - 2) Chaired by the Regional Delegate (RD) with the assistance of the Alternate Delegate (AD)
 - 3) Summary of small group discussions.
 - 4) Open forum for participants to share on NA issues.
